This workshop will cover a wide range of modeling and simulation (M&S) issues, applications, and communities. The Workshop will include multiple tracks and special sessions addressing simulation interoperability issues and proposed solutions; tutorials on state-of-the-art methodologies, tools, and techniques; and exhibits presenting the latest technological advances.

LOCATION. The event will run in the middle of Italian Riviera, few miles from Portofino. The International Genoa Airport guarantees easy access, while the "Superba", once Genoa Maritime Republic, will provide the ideal cocktail mixing beaches, culture, historical sites and entertainment.
