Requirements: Students (e.g. engineering, mathematics, physics, etc.) enrolled in Simulation Researches in Institute, Universities & Agencies are entitled to participate.

Students from all countries are invited to send R&D Papers & Applications.

- Your original Technical/Scientific Poster Paper on the topic “Innovative M&S”, prepared in compliance with the format required for I3M/EMSS Camera Ready Submission (check: [http://www.msc-les.org/conf/emss2016/index\\_file/EMSS\\_AuthorsInstructions.htm](http://www.msc-les.org/conf/emss2016/index_file/EMSS_AuthorsInstructions.htm))
- A Letter from your Tutor/Advisor/Professor confirming your role as student(s) in his institution and providing a recommendation for your activities

Rules:

The applications of the students will be evaluated based on the **Curriculum Vitae** and the **Submitted Paper** .

**NO FEE** is required to submit application to Gianni Cantice Award for Gifted Simulation Students.

The Gianni Cantice Award Committee selects the **Winner**, please note that his decision is final and unquestionable.

The Paper should be original or in publications within I3M2016 (i.e.EMSS,DHSS,IMAACA,HMS,MAS,IWISH) or WAMS2016.

It is responsibility of the Student(s) to deliver the material to [massei@itim.unige.it](mailto:massei@itim.unige.it) and to verify proper delivery of the material, as well as to provide correct references for being contacted and for receiving the Award.

## Application & Paper:

There are two different possibility to submit the paper: one just to the Award Committee and one referring to a Registration to the I3M Conference.

In case the paper is sent only to Gianni Cantice Award for Gifted Simulation Students ([massei@itim.unige.it](mailto:massei@itim.unige.it)), the application is free; please note that these papers will not be published in Conference Proceedings, even if they will be available on I3M archives. As alternative the application could refer to a paper already submitted and accepted for I3M Conference; in this case the paper will be published in I3M Proceedings as usual, upon the completion of the I3M Registration and payment of the related fee.

The submitted papers should be original or in publications within I3M2016 (i.e.EMSS,DHSS,IMAACA,HMS,MAS,IWISH) or WAMS2016.

Special Mention of Appreciation will be provided to the submissions considered of High Quality by the final and unquestionable decision of the Award Committee.

## Fees:

**No Fee** is required to submit application to Gianni Cantice Award for Gifted Simulation Students.

Students aren't required to attend I3M Conference for applying to Gianni Cantice Award, even if, obviously, their participation and registration are welcomed.



## Gianni Cantice Award:

The Gianni Cantice Award Committee selects the winner based on his final and unquestionable decision.

The applications could be submitted by a single student or a team of students; therefore, if a team wins, the award will be assigned to the first student author of the paper and he will be responsible for distributing it among the others.

No advisors or teachers should be awarded and handicaps could be applied in case they are listed among the authors.

The winner receives a cheque sponsored by I3M Organizers as well as the opportunity to visit an International M&S Lab.

Gianni Cantice Award Committee attributes "Certificates of Appreciation" to all valuable papers able to pass selection process based on their final and unquestionable evaluation; all these papers will be presented as poster papers during I3M Conference (the I3M Organization will make them available in I3M archives and will print as posters during I3M).
